**AGREED MOTION TO EXTEND PROCEEDURAL DATES**

Chattanooga Gas Company (“CGC” or “Company”), ConocoPhillips (“ConocoPhillips” or “COP”), and the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of Attorney General (“Consumer Advocate”) on March 23, 2012 submitted a joint proposed procedural schedule for the Hearing Officer’s consideration in the above referenced docket, which Procedural Schedule was adopted by the Hearing Officer.

The parties have been, and continue, serious settlement discussions, including document drafting and review. However, due to the immediate pendency of the time for Chattanooga Gas to file its responsive pleading by June, 5, 2012, it is necessary to request a thirty day extension of all dates previously set in the Procedural Schedule. This extension will permit settlement discussions to continue.

The undersigned counsel for ConocoPhillips is authorized to state that counsel for Chattanooga Gas is in agreement with this requested extension of the Procedural Dates, and that counsel for the Attorney General, Consumer Advocate Division, does not oppose this request.

Therefore, to facilitate continued settlement discussions, Complainant/Petitioner respectfully requests that all dates established in the previously established Procedural Schedule in this Docket be extended for thirty days.
