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**ORDER GRANTING AGREED MOTION TO EXTEND PROCEDURAL DATES**

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This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon an *Agreed Motion to Extend Procedural Dates* ("Agreed Motion") filed by ConocoPhillips Company ("ConocoPhillips") with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA" or the "Authority") on May 29, 2012. In the *Agreed Motion*, ConocoPhillips states that the parties continue to engage in "serious settlement discussions, including document drafting and review." Thus, with no opposition from the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General, ConocoPhillips, with the agreement of Chattanooga Gas Company, requests that all dates in the Procedural Schedule be extended thirty (30) days to accommodate the continuing settlement discussions of the parties. Therefore, finding the request of the parties not to be unreasonable, the Hearing Officer agrees and hereby orders that the deadlines within the Procedural Schedule previously issued on March 29, 2012, be extended thirty (30) days.
