
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**SECOND ORDER EXTENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

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This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA" or the "Authority") upon the filing of an *Agreed Motion for Extension of Procedural Schedule* ("*Agreed Motion*") by Chattanooga Gas Company ("CGC") and ConocoPhillips Company ("ConocoPhillips") on June 21, 2012. In the *Agreed Motion*, the parties state that significant progress has been made in their ongoing settlement discussions and that additional time is needed in which to conclude the discussions. Thus, the parties request that the current procedural deadlines be extended an additional thirty (30) days, and further state that the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General does not oppose the extension of time. Therefore, finding the agreed request not to be unreasonable, the Hearing Officer hereby orders that the deadlines within the Procedural Schedule issued on March 29, 2012, which was extended thirty (30) days on June 4, 2012, be extended an additional thirty (30) days.
