ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO PLEAD AND PRACTICE PRO HAC VICE,
SUBJECT TO SUPPLEMENTAL CERTIFICATION & ACKNOWLEDGEMENT


This matter came before the Hearing Officer upon the *Motion for Admission Pro Hac Vice* of Gregory J. Poulos ("Motion") filed on July 25, 2012, by Frank J. Scanlon, Esq. on behalf of Mr. Gregory Poulos, Esq. In the *Motion*, Mr. Scanlon states that Mr. Poulos seeks to participate in the representation of EnerNOC, Inc. ("EnerNOC") in association with Mr. Scanlon, a practicing member of the Tennessee Bar. In accordance with Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7), which incorporates by reference Rule 19 of the Tennessee Supreme Court, an affidavit and certificate of good standing was attached with the *Motion* attesting that Mr. Poulos is admitted to practice and a member in good standing before the Supreme Court of Ohio. Nevertheless, the affidavit does not include certification by Mr. Poulos that he is familiar with the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct and the rules governing TRA proceedings, license

registration number, or acknowledgement that he will be subject to the rules and procedures governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Tennessee Regulatory Authority.

Upon review and consideration of the *Motion*, the Hearing Officer finds that the *Motion* substantially complies Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7). Accordingly, subject to the filing of the additional certification and acknowledgment described above, the *Motion for Admission Pro Hac Vice of Gregory J. Poulos* to practice before the Authority in the proceedings in this matter is approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Subject to and upon the filing of supplemental certification by Mr. Poulos that he is familiar with the Tennessee Rules of Professional Conduct and the rules governing TRA proceedings, and acknowledgement that he will be subject to the rules and procedures governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, the *Motion for Admission Pro Hac Vice of Gregory J. Poulos*, is GRANTED.
