ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon a *Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule* (“*Motion*”) filed by Kingsport Power Company d/b/a AEP Appalachian Power (“KgPCo”) on August 15, 2012. In its *Motion*, KgPCo requests a modification of the Procedural Schedule established on May 17, 2012, to reflect an extension of time for discovery until August 31, 2012, and a September 14, 2012, deadline for the filing of KgPCo’s rebuttal testimony. On August 21, 2012, Eastman Chemical Company (“Eastman”), Air Products and Chemicals, Inc. (“Air Products”) (collectively, “Industrial Customers”) filed an *Industrial Customers’ Response to Kingsport Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule* (“*Response*”). In its *Response*, the Industrial Customers state that it does not object to the modifications to the procedural schedule requested by KgPCo. Nevertheless, Industrial Customers, noting its concern as to the setting of a hearing

date, requests that the Hearing Officer convene a scheduling conference with the parties. Inasmuch as no party objects to the requested modification of the Procedural Schedule and in the interest of administrative economy, KgPCo's request is granted. Therefore, the Procedural Schedule is modified as follows:

June 15 – August 31, 2012	All parties are permitted to conduct discovery in accordance with TRA Rule 1220-1-2-.11. A copy of each discovery request and response exchanged between the parties shall be filed with the Authority.
September 14, 2012	All parties may file Rebuttal Testimony (limited to scope of supplemental testimony of KgPCo and the direct testimony filed by Eastman, Air Products, DRP, and EnerNOC filed June 11, 2012).
TBD	Pre-Hearing Conference (if needed)
TBD	Hearing on the Merits

In addition, by and with the agreement of the parties, on Monday, August 27, 2012, the Hearing Officer will convene a telephonic conference with the parties for the purpose of discussing the scheduling of a hearing on the merits.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The *Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule* filed by Kingsport Power Company d/b/a AEP Appalachian Power is granted, and the modified Procedural Schedule, as requested and noted herein, is in full force and effect.
