
ORDER CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE
AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority") on April 10, 2012 for the purpose of determining whether to convene a contested case hearing and appoint a Hearing Officer. Eastman Chemical Company and Air Products and Chemicals, Inc. filed a *Joint Petition for Expedited Review to Allow Certain End Use Customers of Kingsport Power Company to Participate in PJM Interconnection Demand Response Programs* on March 30, 2012. The Directors voted unanimously to convene a contested case proceeding and to appoint the Authority's General Counsel or her designee to serve as Hearing Officer for the purpose of preparing the matter for hearing, including but not limited to, entering a protective order, establishing a procedural schedule, and ruling on intervention requests and discovery issues.
