- 12 previously reviewed this document submitted to purportedly
- 13 support the \$26,000.00 McQueen Engineering Services

- 15 MR. GASTEL: May I have a copy of that, please?
- 16 MS. DAVIS: It was previously provided. That
- 17 was your document that was submitted with the request for
- 18 | payment.
- 19 BY MS. DAVIS:
- 20 Q. Do you know how many customers are on
- 21 | this system the Laurel Hills system?
- 22 A. I don't know for sure. From what I have
- 23 heard and talked with them at the TRA meeting, I understand
- 24 | there are about 140 that are paying a monthly fee.
- 25 Q. Do you have experience in how much these

- 1 engineering-type costs for a water system runs in Cumberland
- 2 | County, Tennessee?
- 3 MR. GASTEL: I'm going to object to the form of
- 4 | the question.
- 5 | WITNESS: I use engineers every day for
- 6 things that I'm not sure of. Like in this case, referring
- 7 | to that, what an engineer does on a daily basis, I'm not
- 8 | sure what that would be.

- 12 **Q.** How do you maintain the water towers in
- 13 | the Crab Orchard Utility District?
- 14 A. I have a long-term contract with
- 15 Southern Corrosion, a tank maintenance company that
- 16 | maintains and inspects my tanks.
- 17 **Q.** How much does that run you?
- 18 A. \$54,000.00-and-change per year.
- 19 Q. For the nine (9) tanks?
- 20 A. Yes, ma'am.
- 21 Q. Why are water towers necessary?
- 22 A. Well, we're required by TDEC to have a
- 23 certain amount of storage at least twenty-four (24) hours
- 24 of storage of our water usage. And then the customers need
- 25 | them for fire protection, normally.

- 1 Q. Are you generally familiar with the
- 2 situation and the status of the water tower on Renegade
- 3 Mountain that is part of the water system we're talking
- 4 | about today?
- 5 A. Generally familiar with it. I attended a
- 6 meeting with them and TDEC three or four years ago when TDEC
- 7 was trying to work out something to get them to come into
- 8 | compliance.
- 9 Q. Is that water tank an important part of
- 10 | the water system?
- 11 **A.** Yes, very important.
- 12 **Q.** And how is that?
- 13 A. Well, it's for... If the power goes off,
- 14 | if the electricity goes off at their pump station at the
- 15 | bottom of the hill, the people right on the top of the
- 16 | mountain does not have water service. Immediately, they lose
- 17 pressure. And then also for fire protection. And then times
- 18 when the power is out, then they would have the required
- 19 | water storage.
- 20 Q. If the power goes out, the pumps don't
- 21 | work, is that right?
- 22 **A.** Right.
- 23 Q. Are you generally familiar with the
- 24 | types of work that would be necessary on the water tower in
- 25 order to make it functional and compliant with the TDEC

- 2 A. I know what TDEC requires. As far as
- 3 technically doing it, I'm not familiar with it. But the
- 4 maintenance companies have to submit to TDEC a Plan of
- 5 Action, what they're going to do, and TDEC has to approve
- 6 | it... to be compliant with all the water regulations. So I
- 7 | know what it takes; but how to do it, I don't.
- 8 | Q. Have you reviewed at all the Pittsburg
- 9 | Tank estimates submitted by Laurel Hills as part of its
- 10 request for setting rates for approximately \$127,300.00 in
- 11 | repair costs to put the tank back on line?
- 12 A. No, I haven't reviewed it at all. I've
- 13 heard about it, but I haven't seen it.
- 14 Q. So do you have an opinion about whether
- 15 or not that is a reasonable cost?
- 16 MR. GASTEL: I object to the form. And I will
- 17 | clarify my objection to all these questions. If you are
- 18 | trying to use Mr. Bolin as an expert witness in this case, I
- 19 | don't think that is the proper use of today, given that you
- 20 | haven't complied with any of Rule 26, the obligations of
- 21 | designating an expert witness.
- 22 | BY MS. DAVIS:
- 23 Q. Do you have any opinion about what a
- 24 | reasonable cost to fix that tank would be?
- 25 MR. GASTEL: Object to the form.

1 | WITNESS: I do know that the company that

 $2 \mid$ does mine had gave them an estimate, and they told me it was

3 somewhere in the \$70,000.00 range. Again, you would have to

4 | see the scope of work being done before you could really

5 | know what the cost might be.

- 6 BY MS. DAVIS:
- 7 \mathbf{Q} . Do you know generally the types of
- 8 | repairs that need to be done on this water tower?
- 9 MR. GASTEL: Objection to the form.
- 10 | MR. YORK: I'm going to object unless you
- 11 | qualify that a little bit more. I don't want Crab Orchard to
- 12 | stick their neck out and say they've got to do this and this
- 13 and this. I don't think Everett has looked or inspected it
- 14 | to any degree.
- 15 BY MS. DAVIS:
- 16 Q. Not necessarily inspected it, but are
- 17 | you generally familiar with the types of issues that are
- 18 | presented with this water tower?
- 19 A. I just understand from TDEC... TDEC
- 20 requires them to be inspected and all that, and refurbished
- 21 | inside every so often. And I understand from TDEC that it is
- 22 out of compliance and it needs to be sandblasted and
- 23 | painted, at least inside.
- 24 Q. If theoretically, Crab Orchard Utility
- 25 District had this tank as part of its system, how would you

1 approach getting it back on line?

2 MR. GASTEL: Objection to the form; it calls for

3 | speculation.

4 WITNESS: If we did take it over, then I

5 | would contact my tank maintenance people about adding that

6 to my contract, and work with TDEC and bring it up to

7 | compliance.

8 BY MS. DAVIS:

9 Q. Can you describe some of the contacts

10 and conversations you've had with anybody representing

themselves as representatives of Laurel Hills regarding this

15 came and talked to me a time or two when he came in to pay

his bill, and he said a little bit about what they were

19 that you know about that the Renegade Mountain water system

has had over the past decade or so, and how Crab Orchard

21 | Utility has been involved in some of those issues?

22 A. I don't know really any issues that

23 | we've been involved in except they have had some leaks, and

24 | we went up and installed some valves for them at one time,

25 so they could isolate the leaks. As far as us being

- 1 involved in any issues, I'm not really familiar with them.
- 2 Q. Have various owners of the water system
- 3 asked Crab Orchard Utility to take over the water system and
- 4 provide water services in the past to their customers?
- 5 MR. GASTEL: Object to the form of the question.
- 6 WITNESS: At one time several years ago, one
- 7 of the owners was interested in us taking it over and asked
- 8 | me if we would. At that time, it needed a lot of work done
- 9 on it, and I told them that if they would repair the things
- 10 | that needed to be repaired, then we would consider it. But
- 11 | that would be a board decision from my board.
- 12 | BY MS. DAVIS:
- 13 Q. Sure, okay. Given your historical
- 14 knowledge of the Renegade system, is it accurate to say that
- 15 this system has been experiencing continuing problems over
- 16 | the past decade?
- 17 MR. GASTEL: Object to the form.
- 18 WITNESS: From what I understand from the
- 19 | customers and the people I've talked to up there, it has. As
- 20 | far as me being personally knowledgeable of it, I haven't
- 21 | went and investigated it.
- 22 BY MS. DAVIS:
- 23 **Q.** What types of problems?
- 24 A. No water, threats of turning it off, the
- 25 | water not staying fresh for the customers. Those are issues

- 1 | that I've heard the customers talk about.
- 2 | Q. Have you had the opportunity to analyze
- 3 | the operation and cost associated with operating this water

 - You had mentioned that you had come up with some numbers and I recognize that these may be rough estimates of about a \$40.00 rate to break even. Do you know what makes up that \$40.00, or do you have any type of breakdown of what would be engineering, what would be labor, customer billing, that makes up that \$40.00?
 - A. I haven't really done a breakdown. I was considering my cost of treating the water and my cost of distribution, and there are extra distribution costs of getting it up the mountain that I don't have with my other customers. - 9 A. Accounting and management, I wouldn't
- 10 expect it to be a noticeable difference in those areas.
- 11 Q. "A noticeable difference" from what,

- 13 A. From what we're doing today. I wouldn't
- 14 expect it to add anything to that work load.
- 15 **Q.** So if you were able to assign some of
- 16 your current costs to that, then it would actually reduce




