ISSUED ON APRIL 18, 2013**

Robert E. Cooper, Jr., the Attorney General and Reporter for the State of Tennessee, through the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division ("Consumer Advocate"), respectfully submits this motion to request information on offers.

To ensure the company is in compliance with the Order in Docket No. 12-00030 and providing good faith offers, the Consumer Advocate respectfully requests the Hearing Officer request Laurel Hills Condominiums Property Owners Association ("Laurel Hills") to provide information about the terms of the offers for sale required by the TRA's Order (including but not limited to sales price, payment terms, etc.); when the offers were made; to whom the offers were made (company and contact); and how the offers were made (in writing or orally). The Consumer Advocate suggests this information be provided in 30 days

In addition, the Consumer Advocate respectfully requests the Hearing Officer request Laurel Hills to provide written affirmation that it is maintaining operations in compliance with all laws, including but not limited to staying current on amounts due to vendors providing

services necessary for operations (*e.g.*, Crab Orchard, etc.). Furthermore, the Consumer Advocate requests periodic affirmations on an ongoing basis, perhaps every 30 days, to ensure that any non-compliance can be timely remedied.
