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Comes now Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA" or "Authority") Staff acting as a Party ("Party Staff") appointed in Docket No. 12-00030 who respectfully requests that the Authority reopen the Show Cause proceedings in docket number 12-00077. On April 18, 2013, the Show Cause proceeding in docket number 12-00077 was held in abeyance by the TRA's Order Denying Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and Requiring Divestiture of Water System ("Order"). Petitioner appealed the Order. On April 14, 2014, the Court of Appeals for the Middle District of Tennessee upheld the Order. At this time there is no reason to continue to delay the proceedings in docket number 12-00077.


