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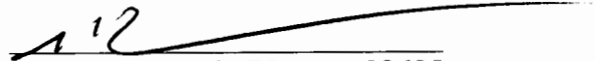

RENEWED MOTION TO INITIATE PROCEEDINGS

Comes now Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA" or "Authority") Staff acting as a Party ("Party Staff") appointed in Docket No. 12-00030 who respectfully requests that the Hearing Officer set this matter for hearing. On August 22, 2012, this matter was held in abeyance by agreement of the parties pending the outcome of docket number 12-00030. On April 14, 2014, the Court of Appeals for the Middle District of Tennessee upheld the Authority's decision in docket number 12-00030. Laurel Hills Condominiums Property Owners Association filed an application for permission to appeal the Court of Appeals decision in docket number 12-00030. On October 15, 2014, the Tennessee Supreme Court denied Laurel Hills Condominiums Property Owners Association application. At this time there is no reason to continue to delay the proceedings.

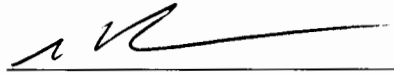
