ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This matter came before the Hearing Officer upon the proposed procedural schedule filed with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") by the Industry Coalition, which is comprised of BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee, the CenturyLink Companies, Frontier Communications Co. of Tennessee/Volunteer and Frontier Communications of America, TDS Telecom, Tennessee Telephone Association, Level 3 Communications, LLC and tw telecom of tennessee, llc (jointly, the "Industry Coalition"), and the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate") on September 6, 2012.

Upon consideration, the Hearing Officer finds the schedule proposed by the parties to be reasonable and hereby adopts it with a slight modification as to the date that the panel will deliberate the merits of the petition. While every effort will be made to accommodate the request of the parties for oral argument in this matter during the November Authority Conference, the setting and deliberations of matters before the Authority are made at the direction and discretion of the voting panel.
