#### **PETITION**

Old Hickory Water, LLC ("Petitioner" or "OHW"), by and through its counsel pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 65-4-101 and 65-4-201 and the Rules of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority" or "T.R.A."), respectfully requests that the Authority grant it a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") and the accompanying authority to provide water and wastewater utility services formally provided by Hickory Star Water Company, LLC ("HSWC"). Due to a foreclosure of another asset of Hickory Star, LLC ("HS"), former parent company of HSWC, HS assigned certain assets, including its membership certificate in HSWC to a bank which in turn sold these assets, including HSWC, to Hickory Star Resort and Marina, LLC, ("HSRM") which transferred its interest in HSWC to Petitioner.

As an immediate consequence of the transaction Petitioner will continue to provide service to customers of HSWC under the same rates, terms and conditions. Accordingly, this transaction will have no effect on the rates, terms and conditions of service of the customers of HSWC.

In support of this petition, petitioners provide the following information:

#### 1. DESCRIPTION OF THE PETITIONER AND RELEVANT ENTITIES

Petitioner, Old Hickory Water, LLC, is incorporated under the laws of the State of Tennessee. Its principal address is 110 Coal Drive, P.O. Box 159, Middlesboro, Kentucky 40965. Articles of Organization for it are attached as **Exhibit A**.

Hickory Star Water Company, LLC was incorporated under the laws of Delaware and was authorized to do business in the State of Tennessee by the Secretary of State on August 4, 1998. HSWC was a public utility pursuant to the laws of the State of Tennessee and its public utility operations are subject to the jurisdiction of the Authority. HSWC was granted its original Certificate of Convenience and Necessity by the Authority on November 24, 1999 in Docket No. 99-00485. HSWC's principal place of business was 6151 W. Century Blvd., Suite 307, Los Angeles, CA 90045. This address is undeliverable.

Hickory Star, LLC was the sole owner of HSWC. HS's principal address was 6151 W. Century Blvd., Suite 307, Los Angeles, California 90045. This address is undeliverable.

The Tennessee Secretary of State lists both as "Inactive – Revoked (Administrative)" as of 10/07/2011 for HSWE and 08/09/2011 for HS. Filing information for HSWC and HS from the Secretary of State web-site are attached as **Exhibit B**.

Prior to the formation of HSWC, the area, including Hickory Star Marina and Campground, was served by a spring near Norris Lake. HSWC was formed at the request of the Division of Water Supply of the State of Tennessee because of a concern over groundwater intrusion into the spring. There was also concern that the spring will not service the increased number of customers in the area. HSWC currently serves approximately 118 customers. The original water lines in the service were old and the Division of Water Supply of the State of Tennessee ordered HSWC to install new water lines which it did.

HSWC purchased water from Maynardville and resold such water to the customers of Hickory Star Marina and Campground. The Authority approved HSWC's existing rates and charges to its customers by Order dated July 22, 2010 in Docket No. 10-00029.

Hickory Star Resort and Marina, LLC ("HSRM") is incorporated under the laws of the State of Tennessee. Its principal address is 110 Coal Drive, P.O. Box 159, Middlesboro, Kentucky 40965.

#### 3. DESCRIPTION OF THE TRANSACTION

HS was the sole owner (sole member) of HSWC, LLC and also sole owner of Hickory Star Marina and Campground. Due to financial difficulties of HS, HS's bank, First Century Bank ("Bank"), Powell, Tennessee, foreclosed on Hickory Star Marina and Campground. As part of the financial arrangements resulting from such foreclosure, HS assigned its sole membership and all other rights in HSWC to Bank. HSRM and OHW were formed to purchase all of HS's interest in HSWC (and other assets including the resort and marina). Bank, in order to remove HSWC from its books in compliance with all state and federal laws and regulations, sold the assets of HS to HSRM. HSWC was sold to HSRM as an interim and pro forma step for HSRM to transfer the assets of HSWC to OHW. Along with the other assets of HS, HSWC had to be sold at the time of the sale, January 1, 2011. The sale was

necessary in order to continue the operation of Hickory Star Marina and Campground and to supply water to the residents who were customers of HSWC. It was necessary to find an owner with sufficient financial, technical, and managerial resources. The Bank had no choice when it sold HS but to sell all of HS's assets, including HSWC, as one package simultaneously. Although it would have been preferable to have been able to obtain Authority approval pre-sale, the circumstances did not allow for such pre-approval. The Bill of Sale from Bank is attached hereto as **CONFIDENTIAL EXHIBIT C**.

As a result of the transaction, HSWC will have its assets transferred to OHW. Pre- and post-transaction corporate structure charts are provided as **Exhibit D**.

HSRM and OHW are owned by John Parton, David Parton, and Dean Knuckles. They are the members of these LLCs.

John Parton and David Parton own and operate Parton Brothers Contracting, Inc. ("PBC"), Highway 441, Middlesboro, Kentucky 40965, which is a private company offering coal mining services. It was established in 1996, incorporated in Kentucky, and employs a staff of 32. The company owns two underground mines. Petitioners, as owners and operators of mines, are familiar with federal and state regulatory frameworks.

Petitioner has the requisite financial stability to operate HSWC. Since the Petitioner is a newly formed companies, financial statements are not available. However, financial statements are available for PBC and Mr. Knuckles and his related entities, including Knuckles Enterprises. Such financial information is being provided herewith as CONFIDENTIAL EXHIBIT E and marked Confidential and Privileged. Additional financial information will be filed in response to the Authority's Data Request.

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John Parton is a one-third (1/3) owner and active member.

David Parton is a one-third (1/3) owner and active member.

Dean Knuckles is a one-third (1/3) owner and onsite manager.

The Partons and Mr. Knuckles have sufficient managerial and technical experience to manage OHW. Their years of experience in the contracting business, trucking, coal hauling and mine construction will be of benefit to managing OHW. Their profiles are attached as **EXHIBIT F**.

John and David Parton and Dean Knuckles all reside within close geographic proximity to OHW and will be able to devote onsite management. Their resources for equipment include equipment owned by PBC and Dean Knuckles Enterprises, Inc. which will be available for any operation, maintenance and repair necessary to the equipment and water lines and sewer lines of OHW.

OHW is in the process of obtaining a surety bond and will furnish such bond when it is obtained.

Petitioner will submit to the Authority all annual reports and other filings in a timely fashion.

Petitioner has furnished the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation ("TDEC") the "Permit Contact information" form as directed by TDEC to transfer the permit to Old Hickory Water, LLC. Such form is attached as Exhibit A to the response to the TRA Data Request which is attached as **EXHIBIT H**.

Pre-filed Testimony is attached as **EXHIBIT G**.

Petitioner's Response to the Authority's Data Request of October 12, is attached as **EXHIBIT H**.

#### 4. PUBLIC INTEREST

Petitioner submits that the transaction described herein will serve the public interest and will enhance the rural community served by OHW. Under new ownership, the water and sewer utility will gain access to the additional resources and operational expertise of Petitioner. Approval of this petition is also in the public interest due to the past precarious financial condition of HSWC. It is also in the public interest in that the Bank is not qualified to run a utility company. With approval of the change of control and authority to provide utility services, OHW customers will receive reliable water and sewage services.

The rates, terms and conditions of services provided by HSWC to its customers will not change as a result of the transaction and granting of the CCN to Petitioner. The transaction will be seamless and transparent to customers and OHW will continue to provide water and sewer services to the former customers of HSWC without interruption and without change in rates, terms or conditions. Future changes in those rates, terms and conditions, if any, will be undertaken pursuant to the applicable notice and tariff requirements.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests the Authority to:

- 1. Grant Petitioner a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide water and waste water services;
- 2. Approve the transfer of certain assets from Hickory Star Water Company, LLC to Petitioner; and
- 3. Grant any other relief as the Authority may deem just and proper.





- A. Our second home is located in Sunset Bay, Sharps Chapel, TN. By land our home is 15 miles from the marina and water company. By water it is 2 miles. I, John Parton, own the lake house and land. I spend two weekends per month there and various holidays

along with staying there if there is business I have to attend at the marina or water company. I am a partner in a company with David Parton that owns a shop building in Tazewell, TN. A lot of my and David's activities in recent years have been dewatering mines, including working under strict regulatory agencies of Federal and State for 34 years. We are experienced in installing, removing and repairing water lines in our business. There is no part of this business operation we are not capable of taking care of David also owns a houseboat located at the marina which he frequents often and makes him accessible to issues at the water company. Dean Knuckles owns a second home also located on Norris Lake. By land it is 10 miles from the marina and water company. By water it is 1 mile. He has been involved with owning and operating construction equipment involving digging and repairing water lines. As you can see, we have connections to the community and are available locally to manage the Company.

- Q. DOES THE COMPANY HAVE THE FINANCIAL RESOURCES NECESSARY TO OPERATE AS A WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY IN TENNESSEE?
- A. Yes. Old Hickory water has the financial resources necessary to operate as a water and wastewater utility in Tennessee. This is demonstrated by the financial information included as exhibits to the Petition and to the Data Request Response.
- Q. DESCRIBE FUNDING ARRANGENENTS, IF ANY, BETWEEN OLD HICKORY
  WATER AND ITS MEMBERS OR OTHER ENTITIES.
- A. The Members will contribute funding if needed.
- Q. HAS THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND CONSERVATION BEEN CONTACTED REGARDING THE PERMIT FOR THE OPERATION WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES?

- A. Yes. TDEC was contacted regarding the permit presently issued in the name of Hickory Star Water and Sewer LLC. TDEC the present permit expires May 29, 2015. TDEC informed our counsel that the permit will remain effective and the transfer can be effected by the furnishing of new contact information and a statement of new ownership. Such information has been furnished to TDEC.
- Q. WILL THE GRANT OF A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

  TO OLD HICKORY WATER, LLC SERVE THE PUBLIC INTEREST
- A. Definitely. Old Hickory Water, LLC will serve the public interest and will enhance the rural community served by the water and wastewater utility. Under new ownership, the water and wastewater utility will gain access to the additional resources and operational expertise of Petitioner. Approval of the Petition is also in the public interest due to the past precarious financial condition of Hickory Star, LLC and Hickory Star Water Company, LLC. With the granting of a CCN to provide utility services, the customers will receive reliable water and wastewater services. The rates, terms and conditions of services currently provided to customers will not change as a result of the granting of the CCN. The transaction will be seamless and transparent to customers and Petitioner will continue to provide water and wastewater services to the former customers of Hickory Star Water Company, LLC without interruption and without change in rates, terms or conditions. Future changes in those rates, terms and conditions, if any, will be undertaken pursuant to the applicable notice and tariff requirements.
- Q. DOES THIS CONCLUDE YOUR TESTIMONY?
