I have a couple of questions concerning the answers on the most recent Data Response, filed April 1, 2013. In establishing the technical expertise of Old Hickory for a CCN, Justin Noah was listed as the technician/person responsible for the day to day operation of the system and the one to respond to emergency situations and or issues/complaints. The answer did not include if Mr. Noah is certificated, so assuming he is not, I need to establish his technical expertise. Could you please just give me some background on Mr. Noah, since he is the one responsible for the operation of the system. Is he an employee of Hickory Star (the marina) presently? How long has he been with Hickory Star? Was he responsible for the day to day operation before the change to Old Hickory?

Previous data responses stated that Michael Payne is not contracted with the Utility nor an employee of the Utility; however, he is a certified technician, does reporting for Old Hickory and is available for emergency situations. Please provide information as to how Michael Payne works with Old Hickory. Did Mr. Payne have this same relationship with the former utility, Hickory Star, and continued on with Old Hickory?
