Allison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 10, 2012 for the purpose of determining whether to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint a Hearing Officer. On May 17, 2012, Atmos Energy Corporation (the "Company") filed its incentive plan reports for the twelve-month period April 1, 2011 through March 31, 2012.

During the Authority Conference, the Directors voted unanimously to convene a contested case proceeding and to appoint the Authority's General Counsel or her designee to act as Hearing Officer to handle any preliminary matters, including entering a protective order.¹
