## ARGEED MOTION TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE FOR THE FILING OF DIRECT TESTIMONY TO AUGUST 27, 2012

The Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate"), the City of Chattanooga ("City") and Walden's Ridge Utility District ("Walden's Ridge") (herein collectively "Requesting Intervenors") respectfully request the Hearing Officer in this matter, Chairman Kenneth Hill, to extend the direct testimony deadline set in this matter from August 20, 2012, to August 27, 2012. Tennessee American Water Company ("TAWC") and the Requesting Intervenors have agreed to the extension and a limit of a total of fifty (50) discovery requests collectively from all intervening parties, including Signal Mountain, that may be propounded on TAWC in the second round of discovery.
