ORDER APPOINTING HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Chairman Kenneth C. Hill, Director Sara Kyle and Director Herbert H. Hilliard of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 15, 2012. Investigative Staff asserts that during the period of December 18, 2008 through April 3, 2012, the Consumer Services Division of the TRA received one hundred and thirteen (113) complaints from twenty-nine (29) Tennessee consumers against David Andrews alleging violations of Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 65-4-501, et seq., known as the "Do-Not-Fax" law.

The panel voted unanimously to appoint General Counsel or her designee to act as Hearing Officer to determine whether a Show Cause Order should be issued against David Andrews based on alleged violations of Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 65-4-501, et seq., and, if a Show Cause Order is issued, to prepare this matter for hearing before the panel.
