

PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE CHANGE NAVITAS TN NG, LLC

On July 2, 2012, Navitas TN NG, LLC ("Navitas"), filed a Petition with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority requesting an adjustment to Navitas' natural gas rates and approval of revised tariff applicable to Navitas' provision of natural gas service to customers in its service area in the State of Tennessee which Navitas believes are necessary in order to provide sufficient revenues to adequately operate the system. On December 17, 2012, Navitas and the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General entered into a Stipulation and Settlement Agreement that proposes changes to the rates charged by Navitas. The proposed changes result in a rate adjustment increase in the amount of \$272,601.00. This will be an overall increase in revenue billed to customers (including purchased gas) of approximately 63 percent. The residential customer charge will have a "phased in" increase gas) of approximately 63 percent.
