

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF
PETITION TO APPROVE AND ENTER SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

Comes now Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("TPUC" or "Commission") Staff acting as Party ("Party Staff") appointed in Docket No. 12-00077 to respectfully give notice of its withdrawal of the *Petition to Approve and Enter Settlement Agreement* ("Petition") filed on February 7, 2019. An identical *Petition* has been filed in Docket No. 12-00030, a case related to this matter. As these two dockets are assigned to different panels, it is necessary to withdraw the *Petition* in this matter to avoid confusion and procedural unintended consequences that may occur from consideration of an identical matter in two separate dockets by two distinct panels. Because divestiture of the water system at issue in both of these docketed cases is ordered in Docket No. 12-00030, it is appropriate for the panel in that case to consider the identical *Petition* filed in that docket. For these reasons, the *Petition* in this docket is withdrawn.

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
