ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE RESPONSE


This matter is before the Hearing Officer on the *Joint Motion to Extend Time to File Response to Customer Intervenor Petition* ("Joint Motion") filed by Laurel Hills Condominiums Property Owners Association and TRA Party Staff (together the "Parties") on November 21, 2014. The Parties request an extension of the time to file a response to the petitions to intervene filed by Gary Haiser et al. and Eagles Nest, LLC on November 18, 2014.
