NOTICE OF BRIEFING SCHEDULE

IN RE: *Complaint of City of Knoxville against AT&T*

DATE: September 13, 2012

The City of Knoxville, Tennessee ("Knoxville"), and Knox County, Tennessee ("Knox County"), each filed with the Authority letters of formal complaint against BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee ("AT&T") on July 24, 2012, and August 15, 2012, respectively. The complaints allege that AT&T is in violation of Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-309(f) for failure to transmit public educational and government ("PEG") channels as required under the Tennessee Competitive Cable and Video Services Act of 2008 ("CCVSA"). AT&T filed its Answers to Knoxville and Knox County on August 24, 2012, and September 12, 2012, respectively. In its Answers, AT&T asserts that it has fulfilled its statutory duty to provide certain PEG equipment and has no subsequent or ongoing obligation to repair, maintain, or replace such equipment.

The parties shall be afforded an opportunity to submit briefs on the issues raised in the pleadings, including the proper interpretation of the requirements contained in the applicable CCVSA provisions. The Authority establishes the following briefing schedule for the parties in this matter:


Initial Party Briefs may be filed no later than **2:00 p.m. on September 28, 2012.**

Reply Briefs may be filed no later than **2:00 p.m. on October 12, 2012.**

Oral argument will be scheduled before the voting panel during the Authority Conference on **November 7, 2012.**

All filings shall be served on the parties by hand-delivery, facsimile or e-mail on the date of filing with the Authority. Any request to modify this schedule shall be made in writing and filed with the Office of the Chairman no later than **2:00 p.m. on Monday, September 25, 2012.**
