ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE RESOLD TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

This matter came before Vice Chair Kenneth C. Hill, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, and Commissioner John Hie of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission" or "TPUC"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on February 18, 2020. Common Point, LLC ("Common Point" or the "Company") was granted authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications by the Tennessee Public Utility Commission ("Commission") on October 15, 2012 in Docket No. 12-00113. A final order was issued on October 31, 2012.

On October 31, 2019, the Commission received a request for cancellation of authority from Common Point. In response to a Commission inquiry, in a letter dated December 10, 2019, BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee stated it is not providing any resold lines or facilities to Common Point, LLC at this time.

Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its

authority.
