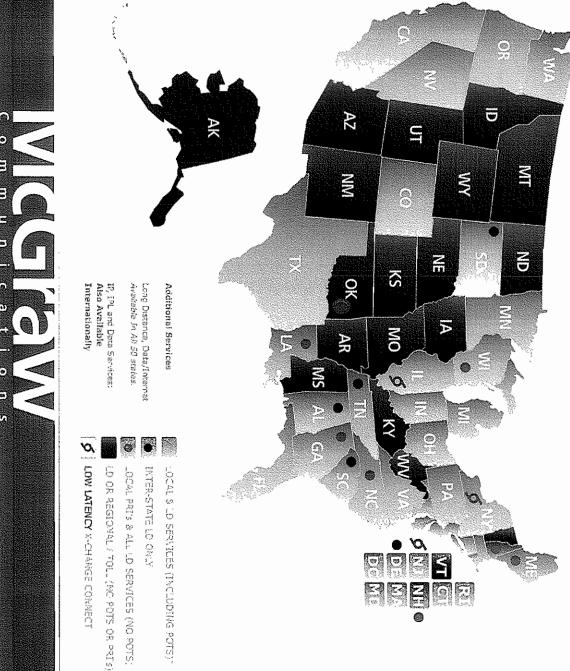

## Service Coverage Map/Low Latency Hubs



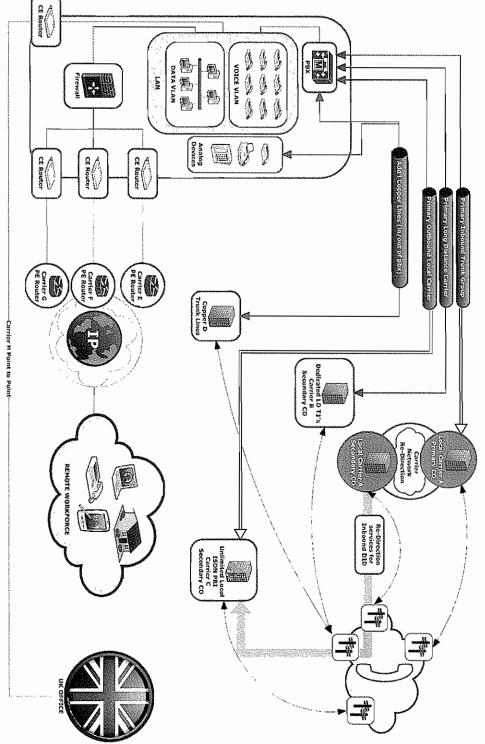
