TO THE PAGING INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**


This matter came before Chairman James M. Allison, Vice Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 17, 2012. The Directors considered approval of the Amendment to the Paging Interconnection Agreement (the "Amendment") negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Tennessee and USA Mobility Wireless, Inc. filed on December 5, 2012.¹

Based upon a review of the Amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Paging Interconnection Agreement* issued on January 4, 2006 in Docket No. 05-00280 and unanimously approved the Amendment.
