Entergy Arkansas, Inc. Request for Approval of Arkansas Nuclear

One, Unit 1 Interim Capacity Cost Recovery Rider

Dear Chairman Allison:

On Monday, January 7, 2013, Entergy Arkansas, Inc. (EAI) filed the proposed Arkansas Nuclear One, Unit 1 Interim Cost Recovery Rider (Rider ANOR) with the Tennessee Reguatory Authority (TRA) for its acknowledgement and approval with rates to be effective with the first billing cycle of February 2013. On Wednesday, January 16, 2013, after learning that EAI's request for approval had been placed on the agenda for commissioner review on February 13, 2013, EAI supplemented its filing with a revised tariff reflecting a March 1, 2013 effective date. Given the limited nature of Rider ANOR, EAI has decided to withdraw its request for approval of Rider ANOR from the TRA. Accordingly, EAI respectfully requests that Tariff Filing No. 13-00003 be removed from the agenda on the next scheduled TRA conference on February 13, 2013 and be withdrawn from consideration by the commission altogether.
