This matter came before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA" or "Authority") during a telephone conference with the parties, Emerson Properties, LLC ("Emerson"), Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. ("TWSI"), and Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Tennessee Attorney General on April 16, 2013, to establish deadlines for responses to TWSI's Counterclaim and Motion to Dismiss filed on March 27, 2013.

During the telephone conference, the parties agreed to the following deadlines designed to efficiently move the docket forward to oral arguments on the motion to dismiss:


Due Date	Filing/Action

April 30, 2013	Response(s) to TWSI Motion to Dismiss*
May 7, 2013	TWSI Reply to Response(s) to Motion to Dismiss*

*All filings are due at 2:00 p.m. CDT on the designated due date.

While every effort will be made to schedule oral arguments during the June 2013 Authority Conference, the inclusion of the docket on the Authority Conference Agenda is subject to the discretion of the voting panel. Therefore, the date for oral arguments will be announced separately upon confirmation by the voting panel. The necessity of additional scheduling of preliminary procedural matters will be determined following the panel's ruling on the motion to dismiss.
