NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO COMMERCIAL MOBILE RADIO SERVICES INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

This Amendment to the Commercial Mobile Radio Services Interconnection Agreement (the "Amendment") negotiated between United Telephone Southeast LLC d/b/a CenturyLink¹ and Dobson Cellular Systems, Inc., American Cellular Corporation and Sygnet Communications, Inc. (now d/b/a New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC and its commercial mobile radio service affiliates, d/b/a AT&T Mobility) was filed with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA") on January 30, 2013.² The Amendment was negotiated pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252. The Amendment has been reviewed, and no portion discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreement.

A Notice was filed by the Authority on April 9, 2013 advising that the Amendment would be deemed approved by the Authority within ten business days of the filing of the Notice unless an objection to the Amendment was filed with the Authority. No objection to the Amendment has been received by the Authority.

Pursuant to the Notice and absent any objection having been filed with the Authority, the Amendment is approved effective as of April 23, 2013.
