NOTICE OF CONSUMMATION & REQUEST TO CANCEL BOND OR LETTER OF CREDIT OF TNCI-DIP

Dear Chairman Allison:

On behalf of TNCI Operating Company LLC ("TNCI-OpCo"), this letter notifies the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") that on August 2, 2013, TNCI-OpCo completed the acquisition of the Ohio customers (including the customers' contracts) and assets (including the Certificate) of Trans National Communications International, Inc. (Debtor-In-Possession) ("TNCI-DIP") as described in the above-referenced Application. As a result of the Transaction, TNCI-OpCo has initiated operations in Tennessee pursuant to the Certificates original granted to TNCI-DIP in Docket Nos. 99-00730 and 05-00147 and TNCI-DIP no longer provides telecommunications services in Tennessee.

Since TNCI-DIP no longer provides telecommunications services in Tennessee and its Certificates have been transferred to TNCI-OpCo, TNCI-DIP requests that the TRA permit the cancellation of any bond or letter of credit that TNCI-DIP may have on file and return it to

TNCI-OpCo is separately filing a Notification of Election to Operate Pursuant to Market Regulation, which explains that tather than adopting TNCI-DIP's retail tariffs, TNCI-OpCo will provide retail services on a detariffed basis and, therefore, such retail tariffs of TNCI-DIP are withdrawn effective upon receipt of the Notification. In addition, TNCI-OpCo separately filed an access tariff in this Docket with respect to the switched access services it offers.
