Notice of Consummation and Cancellation of Certificate of Globalcom Inc. d/b/a First Communications

Dear Chairman Allison:

On behalf of First Communications, LLC ("FCL") and Globalcom Inc. d/b/a First Communications ("Globalcom") (collectively referred to herein as the "Parties"), we hereby notify the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") that the intra-corporate pro forma merger of Globalcom into FCL was completed on July 31, 2013.

As a result of the transaction Globalcom no longer exists as a separate corporate entity and FCL provides service to customers pursuant to FCL's certificate. Therefore, the Certificate of Globalcom should be cancelled effective upon receipt of this letter. Further, in the event that Globalcom has a current bond or letter of credit on file with the Commission, FCL requests that the Commission authorize cancellation of the bond or letter of credit and return it to FCL.
