
**NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS
TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT**

These Amendments to the Interconnection Agreement (the "Amendments") negotiated between United Telephone Southeast LLC d/b/a CenturyLink¹ and Comcast Phone of Tennessee, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Telephone were filed with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA") on May 28, 2013 and June 26, 2013.² The Amendments were negotiated pursuant to 47 U.S.C. §§ 251 and 252. The Amendments have been reviewed, and no portion discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that is not a party to the agreements.

A Notice was filed by the Authority on July 18, 2013 advising that the Amendments would be deemed approved by the Authority within ten business days of the filing of the Notice unless an objection to the Amendments was filed with the Authority. No objection to the Amendments has been received by the Authority.

Pursuant to the Notice and absent any objection having been filed with the Authority, the Amendments are approved effective as of August 1, 2013.
