- 3. Financial information in the form of a Balance Sheet, Income Statement and Statement of Cash Flow along with Revenues and Operating Costs/Expenses for the previous 3 years.
- 4. Pre-filed testimony to substantiate the applicant's managerial, technical and financial qualifications, as well as to describe the services to be offered in Tennessee by Conterra Ultra Broadband, LLC.
- 5. A Small and Minority-Owned Business Participation Plan compliant with Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-112.

It is requested that this information be provided no later than 2:00 pm on August 13, 2013 and that you reference Docket Number 13-00097 on the response. In accordance with TRA rules submit either (1) thirteen written copies of your response or (2) four written copies and an electronic version.
