ORDER GRANTING COMPANY REQUEST FOR CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE CUSTOMER-OWNED COIN/COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICES

This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, Commissioner Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner Clay R. Good, and Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on February 17, 2026. On June 24, 2014, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, now TPUC, issued an order granting Correct Solutions, LLC (“Correct Solutions” or “Company”) authority to operate a Customer-Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone Services (“COCOT”).¹ On December 1, 2025, the Commission received a request from the Company to cancel its COCOT because it has neither active operations nor customers in Tennessee. The Company is in good standing with the Commission concerning payment of mandatory inspection fees. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company’s request to cancel its COCOT.
