**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES**

This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Vice Chairman John Hie, Commissioner Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill, and Commissioner David Crowell of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the “Commission” or “TPUC”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, during a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on May 29, 2025. On June 24, 2014, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, now TPUC, issued an order granting Correct Solutions, LLC (“Company”) a certificate to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services in Tennessee.¹

On March 6, 2025, the Commission received a request from the Company to relinquish its authority pursuant to T.C.A §7-59-307(d), prohibiting the regulation of Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP). The Company is in good standing with the Commission concerning payment of mandatory inspection fees. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company’s request to cancel.
