1	Q1.	PLEASE STATE YOUR NAME, BUSINESS ADDRESS AND
2		OCCUPATION FOR THE RECORD.
3	A1.	My name is Rafael E. Ramon. My business address is 728 S. Jefferson Avenue,
4		Cookeville, TN 38501. I am the Controller for Enrema, LLC ("Enrema")
5		Enrema is an affiliate and service company for B&W Pipeline, LLC ("B&W
6		Pipeline" or "the Company").
7		
8	Q2.	PLEASE PROVIDE A SUMMARY OF YOUR BACKGROUND AND
9		PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE.
10	A2.	A detailed description of my educational and professional background is provided
l 1		in Attachment RER-1 to my testimony. Briefly, I have a Bachelors degree in
12		Civil Engineering, and a Masters degree in Business Administration. I have been
13		employed by Enrema since 2011.
14		
15	Q3.	ON WHOSE BEHALF ARE YOU TESTIFYING?
16	A3.	I am testifying on behalf of B&W Pipeline.
17		
18	Q4.	WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF YOUR TESTIMONY IN THIS
19		PROCEEDING?
20	A4.	The purpose of my testimony is to present information to the TRA on the
21		managerial, financial, and technical capabilities of B&W Pipeline.
22		

1	A5.	B&W Pipeline is a limited liability company authorized to conduct business in
2		Tennessee and is a wholly-owned subsidiary of FIR Energy. The pipeline now
3		owned by B&W Pipeline was formerly owned by Gasco Distribution System
4		which was the parent company of Titan Energy Group, Inc. As part of the Gasco
5		system, the pipeline operated pursuant to Gasco's certificate. Following the
6		bankruptcy of Gasco, the pipeline was separated from Gasco and sold to B&W
7		Pipeline. B&W Pipeline's system is approximately fifty miles long and extends
8		through parts of Pickett, Morgan and Fentress counties.
9		
10	Q6.	PLEASE DESCRIBE THE TERRITORY THAT B&W PIPELINE
11		PROPOSES TO SERVE.
12	A6.	At this time, B&W Pipeline only intends to provide transportation service to
13		Navitas TN NG LLC ("Navitas") which owns the natural gas distribution system
14		formerly owned by Gasco.
15		
16	Q7.	DOES A NEED PRESENTLY EXIST FOR AN INTRASTATE NATURAL
17		GAS PIPELINE IN PICKETT, MORGAN AND FENTRESS COUNTIES?
18	A7.	Yes. All natural gas ultimately sold to customers of Navitas must flow through
19		B&W Pipeline.
20		
21	Q8.	DOES B&W PIPELINE POSSESS THE MANAGERIAL CAPABILITIES
22		TO OPERATE A NATURAL GAS PIPELINE?

1	A8.	Yes. The officers of B&W Pipeline and its affiliates have broad experience
2		working with natural gas systems. In addition, B&W Pipeline has engaged
3		various legal, accounting and regulatory experts to advise and assist it with the
4		managerial responsibilities of operating a natural gas pipeline in Tennessee.
5		
6	Q9.	DOES B&W PIPELINE POSSESS THE FINANCIAL CAPABILITIES TO
7		OPERATE A NATURAL GAS PIPELINE?
8	A9.	Yes. The financial statements that were provided along with our application
9		show that FIR Energy, the parent company of B&W Pipeline, controlled over \$6
10		million in assets at December 31, 2012. In addition, B&W Pipeline is already
11		built and operating and therefore requires no new funding for its completion.
12		
13	Q10.	DOES B&W PIPELINE POSSESS THE TECHNICAL CAPABILITIES TO
14		OPERATE A NATURAL GAS PIPELINE?
15	A10.	Yes. The officers of B&W Pipeline and its affiliates have broad technical
16		experience with the design and maintenance of natural gas pipeline systems.
17		
18	Q11.	HAS B&W PIPELINE SUBMITTED PROPOSED TARIFFS ALONG
19		WITH ITS APPLICATION?
20	A11.	No. In lieu of a tariff, B&W Pipeline has negotiated a special contract with
21		Navitas. A copy of this special contract is included along with our application.
22		

1	Q12.	IS B&W PIPELINE AWARE OF THE TRA'S PIPELINE SAFETY
2		REQUIREMENTS?
3	A12.	Yes. B&W Pipeline will adhere to all of the TRA's safety requirements.
4		
5	Q13.	HAS B&W SUPPLIED THE TRA WITH THE DETAILS OF ITS
6		OPERATIONS?
7	A13.	Yes. B&W Pipeline has supplied the TRA Staff with all of the information that it
8		has sought in its two formal data requests in this docket. In addition, B&W
9		Pipeline has provided follow-up information to the TRA Staff through informal
10		discovery responses.
11		
12	Q14.	DOES THIS CONCLUDE YOUR TESTIMONY?
13	A14.	Yes, it does.
