ORDER APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER

This matter came before Vice Chairman David F. Jones, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director James M. Allison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority" or "TRA"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 20, 2015.

On March 2, 2015, Berry's Chapel Utility, Inc. filed a *Motion for Clarification* ("*Motion*") requesting that the TRA clarify its understanding of the *Stipulation and Settlement Agreement* approved by the TRA at the August 11, 2014 Authority Conference.
