PETITION TO INTERVENE

Robert E. Cooper, Jr., Attorney General and Reporter for the State of Tennessee, by and through the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General ("Consumer Advocate"), pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-118, respectfully petitions the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA" or "Authority") to grant the Consumer Advocate's intervention into this proceeding on behalf of the public interest, because consumers may be adversely affected by Berry's Chapel Utility, Inc.'s, ("Berry's Chapel" or "BCUI") Petition to increase rates. For cause, Petitioner would show as follows:

- 1. The Consumer Advocate is authorized by Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-118 to represent the interests of Tennessee consumers of public utility services by initiating and intervening as a party in proceedings before the Authority in accordance with the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act and Authority rules.
- 2. Berry's Chapel is a public utility regulated by the Authority and provides wastewater service to consumers located in Williamson County, Tennessee. Approximately 800

residential consumers and two non-residential consumers, Walnut Grove Elementary School and Berry's Chapel Church of Christ, receive waste water service from Berry's Chapel.

3. On January 16, 2014, Berry's Chapel filed in the Authority a Petition to change

and increase the rates and charges paid by consumers for wastewater service. The Petition seeks

an increase in operating revenues to \$844,300.00, an increase of \$99,000. Petition at ¶ 3.

According to BCUI, this represents a rate increase of 13.35% for the households, the elementary

school and church served by Berry's Chapel. The Petition also seeks "pass throughs" which

appear to be above the \$844,300 rate increase. Some of the consumers are owed monies

wrongfully collected by BCUI in violation of state law and a settlement agreement. In addition,

BCUI seeks to have ratepayers pay an additional \$1.08 per month for financial security required

to be funded by BCUI.

4. The rate increase, "pass throughs", late charges, application, reconnection and

sewer access fees and monthly fee for bonding sought by Berry's Chapel may not be just and

reasonable and require investigation. In this matter, the Consumer Advocate seeks to represent

the interests of the households and non-residential customers served by Berry's Chapel.

5. Only by participating in this proceeding can the Consumer Advocate work

adequately to protect the interests of consumers.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully asks the Authority to grant the Petition to

Intervene.
