- 2. TWS' detailed plans, if any, from a managerial, technical and financial perspective for resolving the issues set forth in each pending enforcement action. Also include a timetable for resolving each enforcement action.

It is requested that your response be provided no later than May 7, 2014, and that Docket No. 14-00006 be referenced on the response. Pursuant to TRA Rule1220-1-1-.03(4), submit either an electronic response along with an original and four (4) written copies or an original written response and thirteen (13) copies. Please note that the requisite number of written copies of all requested information should be provided to the Docket Manager and electronic responses, if filed, must be in .pdf format.
