Thank you for your recent inquiry. As you noted, on January 12, 2015, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority granted, without restriction, Plains and Eastern Clean Line, LLC's Petition for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) to construct and operate electric transmission facilities in the state of Tennessee. When it is issued, the Authority's Order will reflect its actions taken on January 12, 2015.

As a general matter, electrical power companies in Tennessee have statutory authority, subject to certain obligations and procedures, to condemn and acquire property for public use (i.e., eminent domain). As a public utility providing electric transmission services, Clean Line has authority to exercise and must comply with all of the attendant rights and duties of such utilities under Tennessee law.
