**ORDER CONVENING A CONTESTED CASE
AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER**

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Vice Chairman David F. Jones and Director Robin Bennett of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on September 15, 2014 to determine whether to convene a contested case proceeding and appoint a Hearing Officer. On April 24, 2014, Berry's Chapel Utility, Inc. notified the Authority that it will now be operating under an assumed name, Harpeth Wastewater Cooperative. The Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General filed a *Petition to Intervene* on September 3, 2014.

During the Authority Conference, the Directors voted unanimously to convene a contested case proceeding and to appoint the Authority's General Counsel or her designee to act as Hearing Officer to prepare this matter for hearing, including but not limited to, establishing a procedural schedule, entering a protective order, and ruling on intervention requests and discovery issues.
