**AGREED MOTION TO SET TIME FOR RESPONSE TO DISPOSITIVE MOTIONS**

Aeneas Communications, LLC ("Aeneas") filed the above-captioned complaint on July 8, 2014 against Jackson Energy Authority ("JEA").

On August 7, 2014, JEA filed an answer to the complaint as well as a motion to dismiss the complaint and a motion "in opposition to commencement of a contested case."


Under TRA rule 1220-1-2-.06(2), "Any party opposing a motion shall file and serve a response within seven (7) days after service of the motion." The rule is entitled "Preliminary Motions" and appears intended to address procedural requests, not the type dispositive motions filed by JEA.

Because JEA's motions request a dispositive ruling on the merits of the complaint, Aeneas requests additional time to respond. Counsel for Aeneas and counsel for JEA have agreed that Aeneas may file its responses to the motions on or before August 28, 2014.

Therefore, Aeneas asks that it be granted until August 28, 2014 to respond to the motions filed by Aeneas. Counsel for JEA has stated that JEA agrees with this request.
