**ORDER APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER**

This matter came before Chairman Herbert H. Hilliard, Director Kenneth C. Hill and Director Robin Bennett of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on October 10, 2014 to determine whether to appoint a Hearing Officer. On July 8, 2014, Aeneas Communications, LLC filed a *Complaint and Request for Interim Relief* ("Complaint") pursuant to state and federal law against Jackson Energy Authority, followed by amendments to the *Complaint* on August 7, 2014.

During the Authority Conference, the Directors voted unanimously to appoint the Authority's General Counsel or her designee to act as Hearing Officer for the purpose of establishing a procedural schedule, entering a protective order, and ruling on intervention requests and discovery issues.
