Exhibit 2 includes Articles of Incorporation for "ClearLinx Network Corporation" and a certification letter from the Delaware Secretary of State indicating "ExteNet Systems, Inc. was incorporated on the first day of October A.D. 2002."
- 3) What is the relationship between ClearLinx Network Corporation and ExteNet Systems, Inc.?

It is requested that this information be provided no later than 2:00 pm on November 20, 2014 and that you reference Docket Number 14-00092 on the response.
