ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE

This matter came before Vice Chairman Robin L. Morrison, Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard and Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on July 10, 2017. Lattice Incorporated (the "Company") filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee on September 29, 2014. During a Commission Conference held on November 4, 2014, the Commissioners found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application. On June 16, 2017, the Commission received a request from the Company to cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.¹
