ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE

This matter came before Chairman David F. Jones, Vice Chairman Robin L. Morrison and Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on October 23, 2017. Larry Travis d/b/a Coin Tel Systems (the "Company") filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone ("COCOT") service within the State of Tennessee in 1990. The Tennessee Public Service Commission found that the Company had met all the requirements to provide COCOT service and approved the Application. On October 6, 2017, the Company's request to cancel its authority was filed in the docket file. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
