JOINT NOTICE OF CHATTANOOGA GAS COMPANY AND VOLKSWAGEN GROUP OF AMERICA, INC. REGARDING CONSOLIDATION OF CHATTANOOGA OPERATIONS

Chattanooga Gas Company ("CGC") and Volkswagen Group of America, Inc. provide this joint notice to advise the Commission of information concerning the corporate organization of Volkswagen's Chattanooga operations.

Volkswagen Group of America, Inc. is the entity that is responsible for all of Volkswagen AG's operations in the United States. Volkswagen Group of America, Inc. established Volkswagen Group of America Chattanooga Operations LLC ("Volkswagen Chattanooga Operations LLC") as a wholly-owned, single-member, member-managed Tennessee limited liability company when it began operations in Chattanooga in 2010. The Commission approved in this Docket a special contract (the "2014 Special Contract") with the limited liability company that has supported the growth and expansion of the Chattanooga Volkswagen operations.

Effective January 1, 2024, Volkswagen Chattanooga Operations LLC, the single-member operations LLC wholly owned by Volkswagen Group of America, Inc., was merged into its parent company. The merger of Volkswagen Chattanooga Operations LLC into its parent reinforces Volkswagen's commitment to its Chattanooga operations and has been undertaken to

strengthen and streamline the Volkswagen organization in the North American region as Volkswagen pursues further growth.

The merger of Volkswagen Chattanooga Operations LLC into its parent corporation resulted in no change in Volkswagen's Chattanooga operations. Pursuant to paragraph 23 of the 2014 Special Contract, that Contract became binding upon Volkswagen Group of America, Inc. as of the date of the merger. Volkswagen Group of America, Inc. will continue to abide by all terms of the 2014 Special Contract.

Volkswagen Group of America, Inc. and Volkswagen Chattanooga Operations LLC provided notice to CGC of the merger, and CGC acknowledged and expressed its consent to the succession of Volkswagen Group of America as the Customer under the 2014 Special Contract, in accordance with the terms of the 2014 Special Contract. A copy of the notice and acknowledgment is attached as Exhibit A.
