## **DIRECT TESTIMONY OF JOSEPH FEROWICH**

- Q: State your name and address.
- A: Joseph Ferowich, 1136 N Shorewood Lane, Caryville, TN 37714.
- Q: What is your profession?
- A: I am a licensed professional engineer in the State of Tennessee.
- Q: Provide a summary of your background and professional experience.
- A: I have over 30 years of commercial and residential site development experience. I have been designing alternative sanitary sewer disposal systems for approximately 7 years. The last system I designed was for the Sunset Gap Community Church in Newport, TN, which was done last year.
- Q: On whose behalf are you testifying?
- A: Summit View Resorts Homeowners' Association.
- Q: What is the purpose of your testimony in this proceeding?
- A: My testimony was requested because of my familiarity with on-site wastewater systems and my experience in evaluating said systems. The purpose of my testimony is to provide a checklist for conducting an evaluation of on-site wastewater systems.
- Q: Have you previously worked with an on-site wastewater system like the one in Summit View?
- A: Yes.

## Q: If you were requested to evaluate an existing on-site wastewater system, what would you need to do?

- A: I would need to perform an evaluation including these items below:
  - 1. Review the approved plans,
  - 2. Review the State Operating Permit,
  - 3. Review Quarterly Monitoring Reports,
  - 4. Review files from the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation,
  - 5. Review and evaluate the actual treatment flows and how they are determined,
  - 6. Have a Tennessee Licensed Soil Scientist review existing Soil Maps with field verification.
  - 7. Perform a field inspection for verification of the site conditions, and
  - 8. Perform calculations to verify treatment and disposal system.

## Q: Would this be all you need to do?

- A: The evaluation may lead to additional questions and other work may be needed.
- Q: If issues are found, are you capable of putting together a recommendation for modifications?
- A: Yes. With cooperation from a Tennessee Licensed Wastewater Operator, and a Tennessee Licensed Soil Scientist many options can be considered.
- Q: Assuming the issue with the Summit View system is due to over usage, are there remedial measures that can be taken to solve the problem, other than system expansion?
- Y: Yes. One alternative would be to add sufficient storage to be able to equalize flow.
- Q: Does this conclude your testimony?
- A: Yes.
