**ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY
TO PROVIDE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES**

This matter came before Commissioner Herbert H. Hilliard, Commissioner Kenneth C. Hill and Commissioner Keith Jordan of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission (the "Commission"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 10, 2017. Lattice Incorporated (the "Company") filed an Application for authority to provide operator services and/or resell telecommunications services in Tennessee on November 19, 2014. During a regularly scheduled Commission Conference held on February 9, 2015, the Commissioners found that the Company had met all the requirements for certification and approved the Application. On June 16, 2017, the Commission received a request from the Company to cancel its authority. Based upon careful consideration of the entire record in this matter, the Commissioners voted unanimously to grant the Company's request to cancel its authority.¹
