Dear Mr. Bressman:

On November 21, 2014, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("TRA") received your application, filed on behalf of Google Fiber Tennessee, LLC ("Google Fiber"), for a certificate of franchise authority pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 7-59-301, et seq., also known as the Competitive Cable and Video Services Act (the "CCVSA"). Because Google Fiber is not a provider deemed by "operation of law to have the managerial, financial and technical qualifications to obtain a state-issued certificate of franchise authority," the Authority requested additional information from which to evaluate Google Fiber's qualifications in a letter dated December 4, 2014. On February 4, 2015, Google Fiber filed responses to the TRA's requests in the above-noted docket file.

Upon review of your responses, the Authority has determined that your application now complies with the statutory requirements of the CCVSA and is therefore complete. In accordance with the CCVSA, the Authority will proceed on Google Fiber's application, and anticipates issuing a Certificate of Franchise Authority in this matter.
