Notice is hereby given that Atmos Energy Corporation (the Company) filed a Petition with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (TRA) on November 25, 2014 in Docket 14-00146, proposing to change its rates for natural gas service now in effect. The rates proposed by the Company are subject to approval by the TRA. The TRA may adopt, reject, increase or decrease any of the proposed rates in part or in whole. A complete copy of the proposed rate changes and the reasons for them are on file with the TRA and are available for public inspection. A complete copy is also available in the Company's local offices. The Company has requested this change in rates in order to permit it an opportunity to recover its reasonable operating costs and to earn a fair and reasonable return on its investments. The predicted impact of the proposed changes on the average residential customer is an increase of approximately \$25.06 per year. The predicted impact of the proposed changes on the average small commercial class customer is an increase of approximately \$109.86 per year. The matter is set for hearing May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2015, beginning at 9:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as it may be heard, in the TRA's Hearing Room on the ground floor of the Andrew Jackson State Office Building, 500 Deaderick Street, Nashville, Tennessee.
