**ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF FOR SIXTY (60) DAYS
AND APPOINTING A HEARING OFFICER**

This matter came before Vice Chairman David F. Jones, Director Robin Bennett and Director James M. Allison of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 12, 2015. On December 12, 2014, King's Chapel Capacity, LLC ("King's Chapel") submitted a tariff to true-up the bonding costs it recovers from its customers. The tariff changes have a proposed effective date of February 1, 2015.

During the Authority Conference, the panel found that additional information is needed to properly review and evaluate the proposed tariff changes and voted unanimously to suspend King's Chapel's proposed tariff for sixty (60) days from February 1, 2015. The panel further voted unanimously to appoint the Authority's General Counsel or her designee to act as Hearing Officer to rule on intervention requests and discovery issues, including entering a protective order, if necessary.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
