

ORDER RE-SUSPENDING TARIFF THROUGH SEPTEMBER 14, 2015

This matter is before the Hearing Officer of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“TRA” or “Authority”) to address the preliminary issues that arise during the preparation of this matter for a hearing before the Authority. As the preparation of this matter continues, consistent with Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 65-5-103(a) and (d), and without objection from the parties,¹ the Hearing Officer finds that the effectiveness of the proposed tariff changes should be re-suspended **through and including September 14, 2015**, or until further order of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority, whichever occurs sooner.
